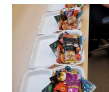
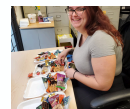
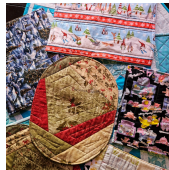
Like every year, our clients will be receiving many goodies and treats from the community this holiday season!
